



PIERRE ANCTIL

President and Chief Executive Officer, Axiom Infrastructure

Pierre Ancil has more than 30 years of experience in principal investing, strategic and executive management, business development and public service.

As co-founder of Axiom Infrastructure, Pierre was instrumental in raising the firm's inaugural C\$460 million Canadian-focused infrastructure fund – Axiom Infrastructure Canada LP. As President and Chief Executive Officer, and Chairman of the fund's investment committee,

Pierre has provided strategic leadership and executive oversight on all portfolio investments completed by the fund.

Pierre began his career in 1984 as a project manager at Pellemon Inc., a consulting engineering firm specializing in infrastructure where he managed project teams across all aspects of civil and building works including architecture, structural, mechanical and electrical engineering.

Pierre left Pellemon in 1988 to serve as General Manager of the Québec Liberal Party, a position he held until early 1994. In 1994, he was appointed Chief of Staff to the Premier of Québec. From late 1994 to 1996, Pierre served as Chief of Staff to the leader of the official opposition in Québec's National Assembly.

In early 1996, Pierre returned to Pellemon as Executive Vice-President and Member of the Board of Directors, where he developed a strategic plan for the company that involved a restructuring of its corporate share ownership and sale to SNC-Lavalin - one of the world's leading engineering and construction firms (TSX: SNC).

In conjunction with the sale of Pellemon, Pierre joined SNC in 1997 as Senior Vice-President and General Manager of its Investment Division. In 2001, he was promoted to Executive Vice-President and Member of the Office of the President where he held responsibility for investments in infrastructure projects. Over an 11-year period, he developed experience bidding, developing, building and overseeing the operations of the firm's infrastructure portfolio, with an estimated equity value of approximately C\$2.5 billion (as at Dec 2007) at the time he left SNC in early 2008. He co-founded Axiom Infrastructure in late 2008. Project companies included toll roads, bridges, mass transit, airports, power generation and transmission facilities and gas distribution. While heading SNC-Lavalin's Investment Division, Pierre played a key role on some of the most significant infrastructure transactions in Canada including the 407 Electronic Toll Road privatization, acquisition of the Altalink transmission asset from Transalta and the Canada Line greenfield mass transit system project.

Pierre is Chairman of the Board of the Montréal Heart Institute. Throughout his career, he has served as a member of various boards of directors, most notably he was a member of the Board of Directors of GazMétro from 2004 to 2015. He also was a member of the board of directors of 407 International, where he served as Chairman of the Executive Committee until June 2008, of Altalink and of the Laurentian Bank of Canada.

Pierre holds a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering from the École Polytechnique de Montréal, and an MBA from HEC Montréal.
